The next EurofamNet Training School on family support and research for social impact within the framework of the Cost Innovators Grant (CIG IG18123) will take place at the Faculty of Human and Social Sciences (Ed. 1) in Gambelas Campus of the University of Algarve, located 6 kms from Faro, 5 kms from the beach and 3.5 kms from the airport.



Transfers from Faro International Airport to Faro city and to University of Algarve

Public Transport:

There is very limited public transport from Faro airport to Faro city. There is a single bus service (€2.35 adult) that departs every 30-40 minutes between 6am and midnight.

This bus (**route 16**) terminates at the Proximo bus station, and is next to the intercity bus station or 200m from the train station.

The bus PROXIMO (**Route 18**) connects Faro central station (next to Hotel Eva) with the Gambelas campus of University of Algarve.

Taxi Service:

A taxi from the airport to Faro is a more convenient and faster option, costing €15-20. Uber operates in the Algarve, but there can be high demand during the summer months. The price for a private transfer (with a driver waiting at the airport for you) to Faro, is from €25

Logistics

The meeting room is equipped with WIFI. Attendees who are on Eduroam can access automatically, for those who are not, the password will be provided at the meeting venue.

Coffee breaks will be served at the conference venue.

Lunch will be served in the premises of the University (**Restaurante Universitário, 1st floor Building 6**, <https://www.ualg.pt/en/bars-canteens-and-restaurants>). It is proposed to have launch together, **although each participant will pay for their own lunch as part of the daily allowance rate provided by COST**. Lunch cost is approximately 10€. Also, there are several nice cafés and

restaurants within walking distance (less than 5 minutes walk from the faculty), for instance, Art Café, Bistro Café, San Remo Restaurant.

On the evening of the 4th, our Local Organiser will provide a city tour of Faro.

On the evening of the 4th July, there will be a joint dinner for all the meeting participants that want to attend. A restaurant will be booked by the Local Organiser. Dinner cost is approximately 40-50€. **Each participant will pay for their own dinner as part of the daily allowance rate provided by COST.**

Either for lunch and dinner, **attendance will need to be confirmed in advance when requested and will be paid at the time of registration.**

According to COST rules, the daily allowance rate for Portugal is 195 euros. That rate is aimed to cover accommodation, lunches, dinners and local transport (see further information at the Daily Allowance Table: https://www.cost.eu/uploads/2022/04/2022_Daily-allowance-table.pdf).

Please be aware that cancellation insurance fees are eligible to be reimbursed and COST recommends to buy them. Travelling derogations are also covered by COST. What to do and see in Faro



Faro is a historic and culturally rich city that boasts a variety of fascinating tourist attractions. Found within the historic quarter (the Cidade Velha) is a Gothic cathedral, the Paço Episcopal palace and the decorative Arco da Vila gateway. Outside of the city walls is a vibrant city, with pedestrianized shopping streets, characterful plazas and a wide variety of restaurants and bars.



To the south of Faro is the Parque Natural da Ria Formosa, a series of saltwater lagoons and waterways, which is an important ecosystem for migratory birds and marine life. On the seaward side of the Ria Formosa are three sandbar islands, and these are the location of Faro's pristine beaches.



Interesting sights to see:

Faro Marina, Manuel Bivar plaza, Igreja da Misericórdia (church), Arco da Vila (gateway), Porta Nova, Se Cathedral, Câmara Municipal (City Hall), Faro

Museum, Arco do Repouso (gateway), Rua de Santo António (shopping street), Igreja de São Pedro, Igreja do Carmo and Capela dos Ossos.

Sights around Faro: Cabo de Santa Maria, Ilha Deserta, Culatra fishing village.

Also, Faro is a good base from which to explore the Algarve by public transport. Tavira is only 40 minutes by train to the east, Vilamoura is 30 minutes by bus to the west, and even Lagos at the very western edge of the Algarve, can be reached by a direct train.
