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Research: ethical, political & educational nature

Sociocritical research **paradigm => Transformation**

Social Science => **Better society** => Social Justice, Inclusion, etc.

Social researchers "must ask themselves about ethical issues" (Measor & Sikes, 2004, p. 291).

To make social problems visible and analyse them and to envisage ways of solving them.

Political: it puts on the table the need to **address these problems**.









Giving a voice to those who don't usually speak out, or are heard => a democratising element.

COUNTER-NARRATIVES show diversity, question discourses, break prejudices, etc.

The stories have the power to "create bridges between diverse worlds; to force us to confront worlds different from our own; to combat injustices; and to initiate a process of change in ourselves" (Witherell, 1998, p. 83)









Making public these realities => "conscientization" effect (Freire, 2002) => Social Education.

These products aim to raise awareness and **stimulate** the **development** of an **ethical conscience** that stimulates learning and encourages **greater civic engagement and political participation**.

They contribute to the **emancipation and dignification** of **people** experiencing **difficulties**.




